Obituaries

Rev. Kevin J. Baglole, 54, died Jan. 29, in Hamilton. He was a psychosocial spiritual bereavement clinician with the Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant Local Health Integration Network.

He also served many Lutheran and Anglican congregations, and as a chaplain and administrator in Long-Term Care facilities.

Rev. Theodore Becker, 91, died Jan. 26 in Calgary. He served six different congregations in Western Canada from 1952–92. He then served four years at Bethany Care Centre, Calgary.

Dr. Gerhard Driedger, 92, died Jan. 23 in Lethbridge, AB. An orthopedic surgeon, he served as a medical missionary at the Lutheran Hospital in Yagaum, New Guinea from 1969–70.

Myrtle Frostad-Cooper, 92, died Jan. 18 in Stasbourg, SK. She served as a church organizer for 72 years, including playing for services where her husband, the late Rev. Harold Frostad, served.

Edna Monk, 107, died in Kitchener, ON, on Jan. 23. As a deaconess she served churches throughout the Northeastern USA and Kitchener, ON, 1942–58; with the Department of Evangelism of the Lutheran Church in America until 1973 and St. Peter's, Manhattan, until 1975.

Doreen Nostbakken, 89, died in Saskatoon, on Jan 30. A registered nurse, she and her

husband, Rev. Paul Nostbakken, served in Cameroon and the Central African Republic.


