## Obituaries

**Rev. Frank William Schmitt** (1931–2017) died peacefully in his sleep at home on Tuesday, July 11. Frank ministered in the U.S. for two years before being called to Canada as a mission pastor in 1961. He was a pastor of six parishes in his 50-plus years of ministry. After retirement from full-time ministry in 1993, Frank continued

to serve for fifteen years as a part-time and supply pastor in several churches throughout B.C.

**Rev. Donald L. Miller**, 88, died Aug. 7 in Selkirk, MB. Before he entered pastoral ministry, his sister Mary Lou and he performed as The Curtis Twins, dancing at nightclubs throughout Pennsylvania and eventually New York City. Gene Kelly was one of their teachers. He served congregations in Oregon, Alberta (Meeting Creek, Camrose, Edmonton), and in Manitoba (both in Winnipeg and rural Manitoba).
